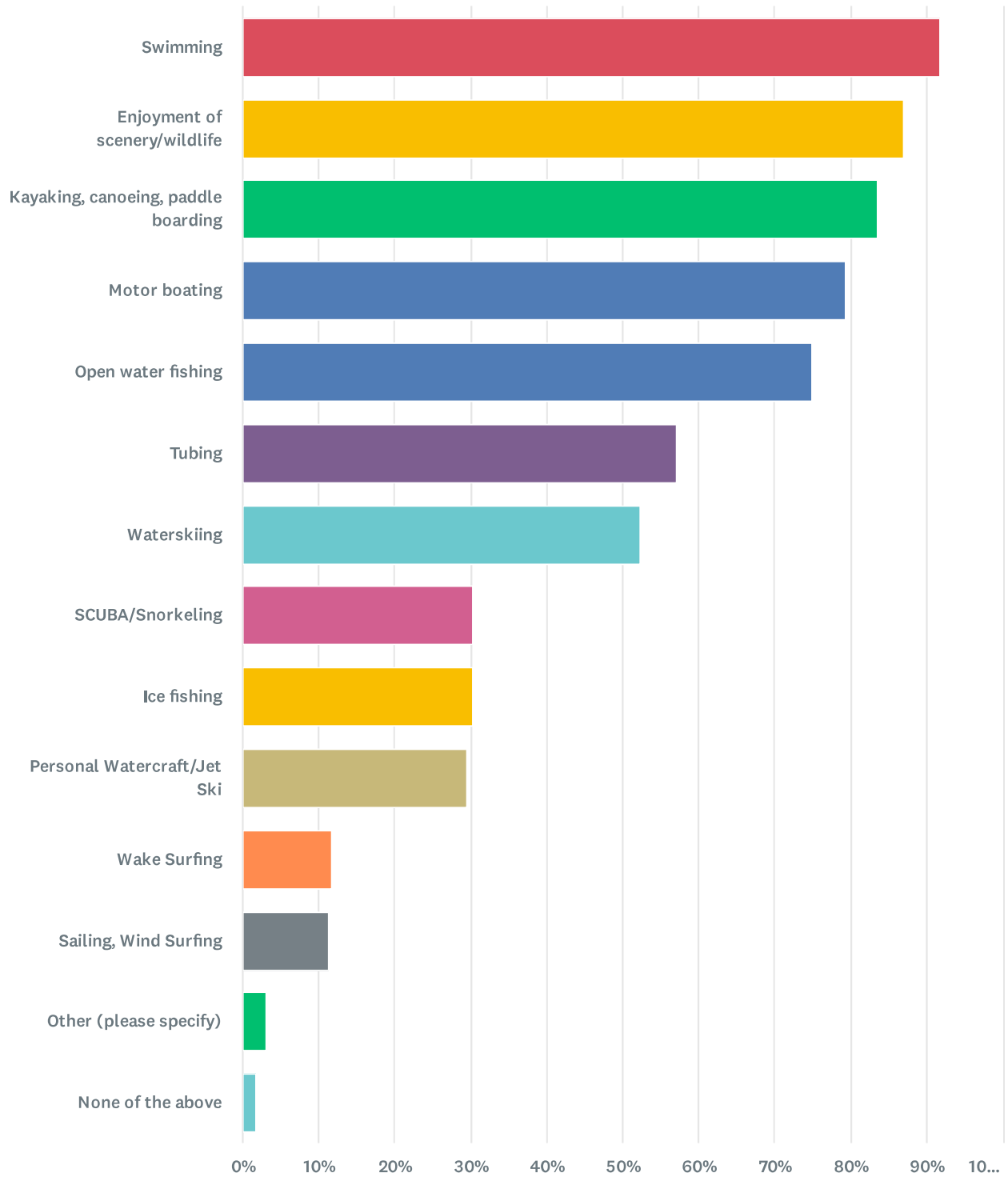
Q4 Are you presently or in the past been a member of the Lake Lucerne Advancement Association?

Q5 Which recreational activities do you participate in on Lake Lucerne? (Please check all that apply)

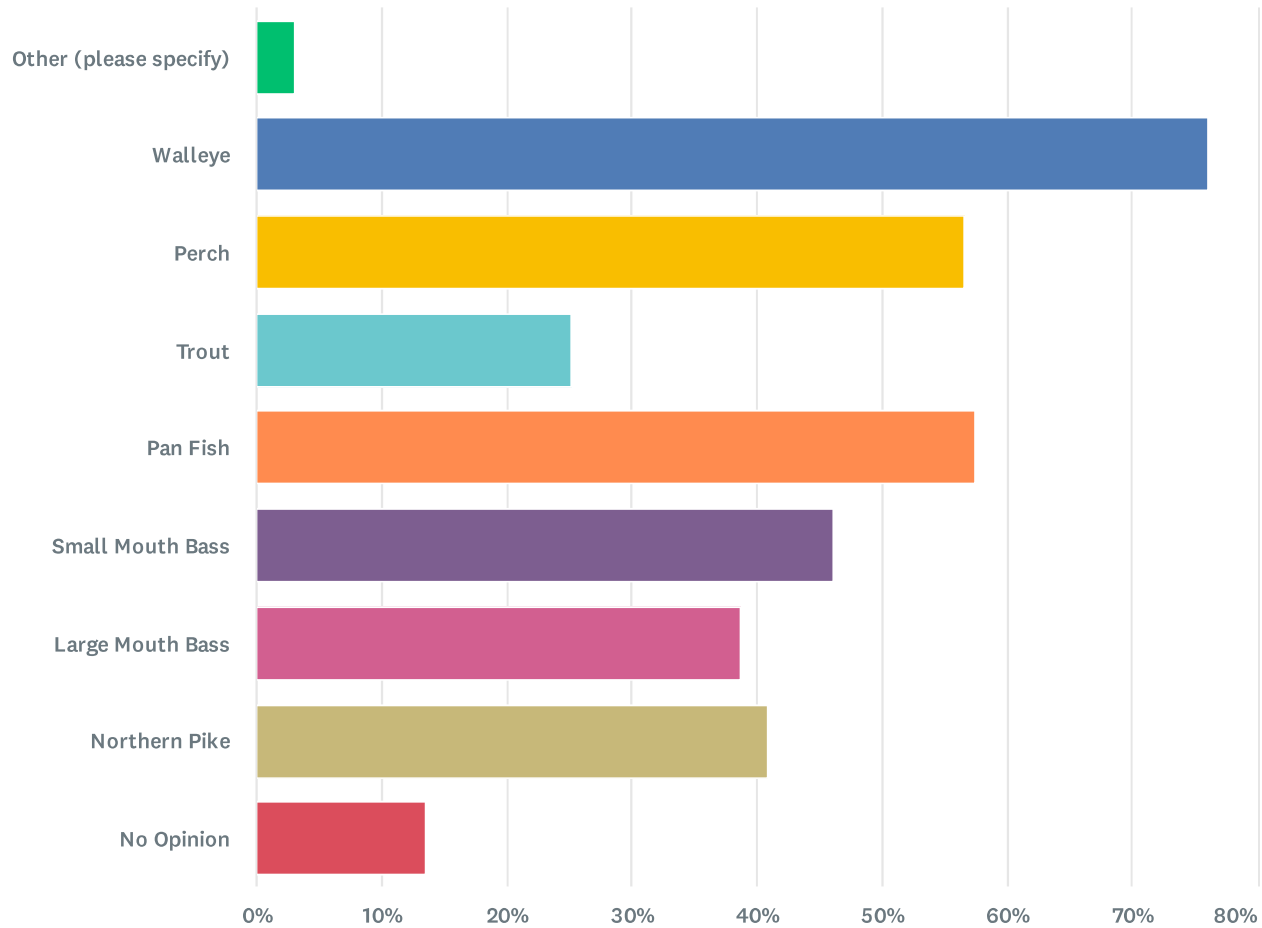

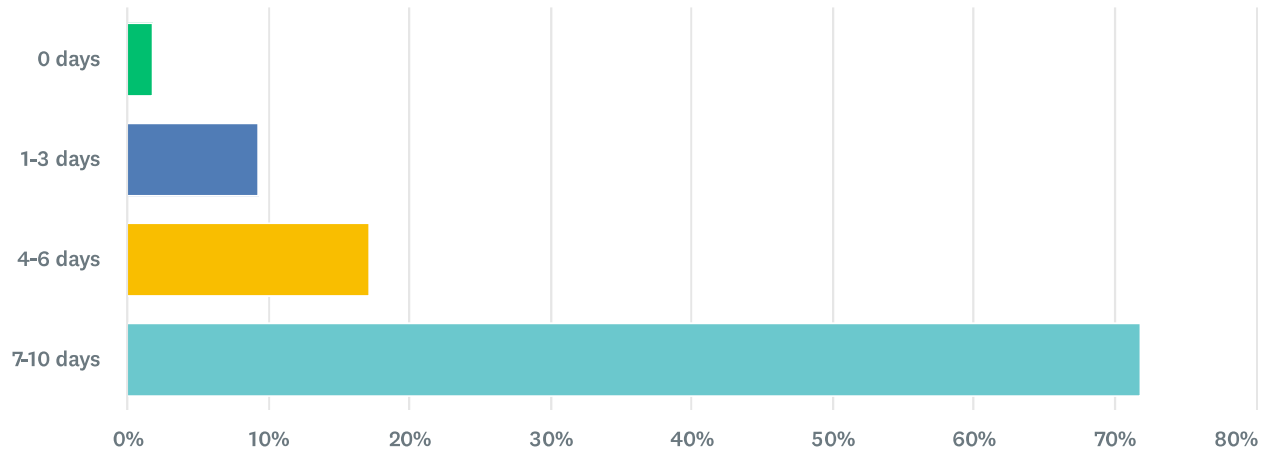
Q9 How many days between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend do you spend at Lake Lucerne? (there are approximately 100 days between these periods)

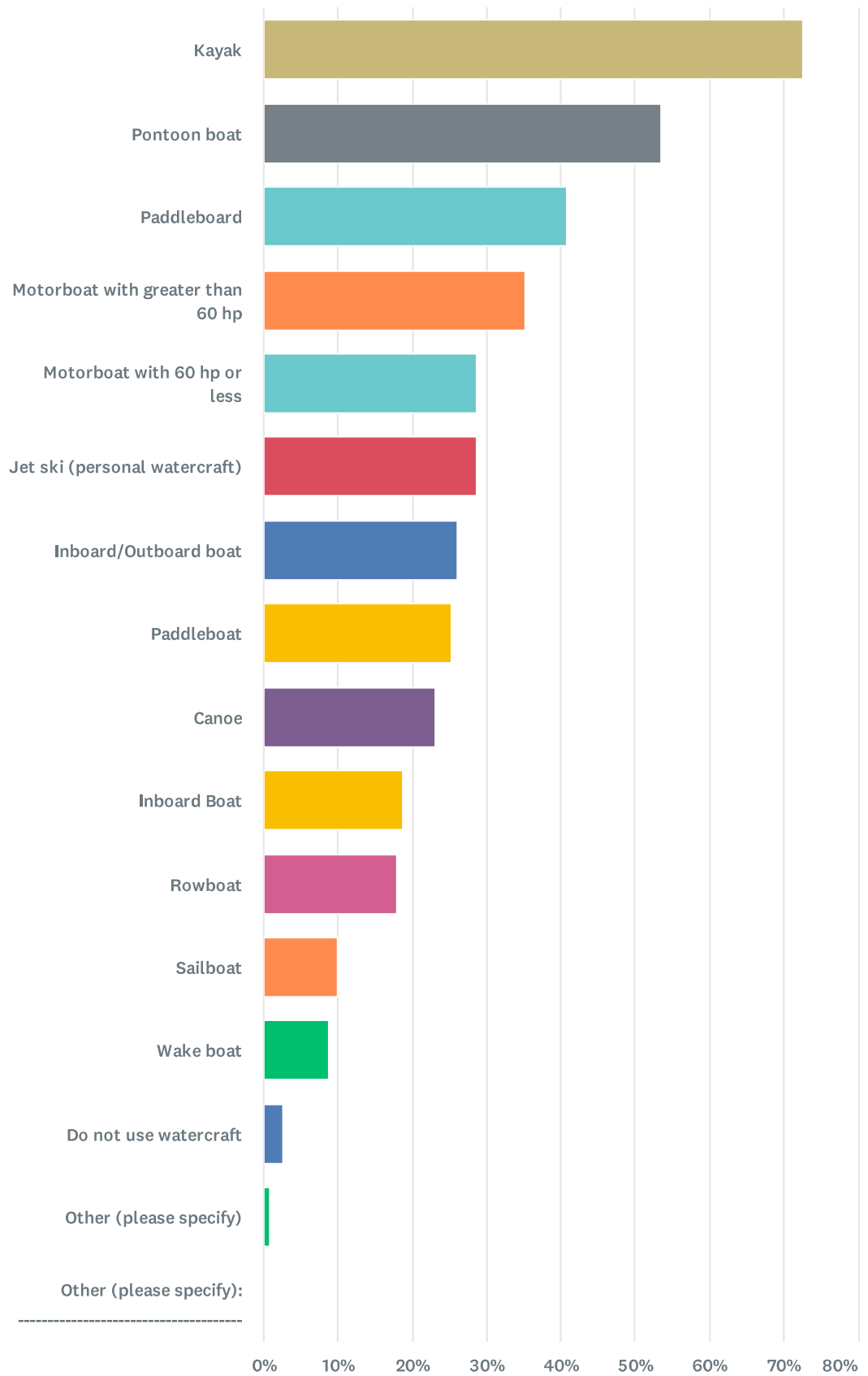
Q10 In a typical summer, out of every ten days spent at Lake Lucerne, how many do you spend recreating on or by the water?

Q11 What types of watercraft(s) do you use on Lake Lucerne? (check all that apply)

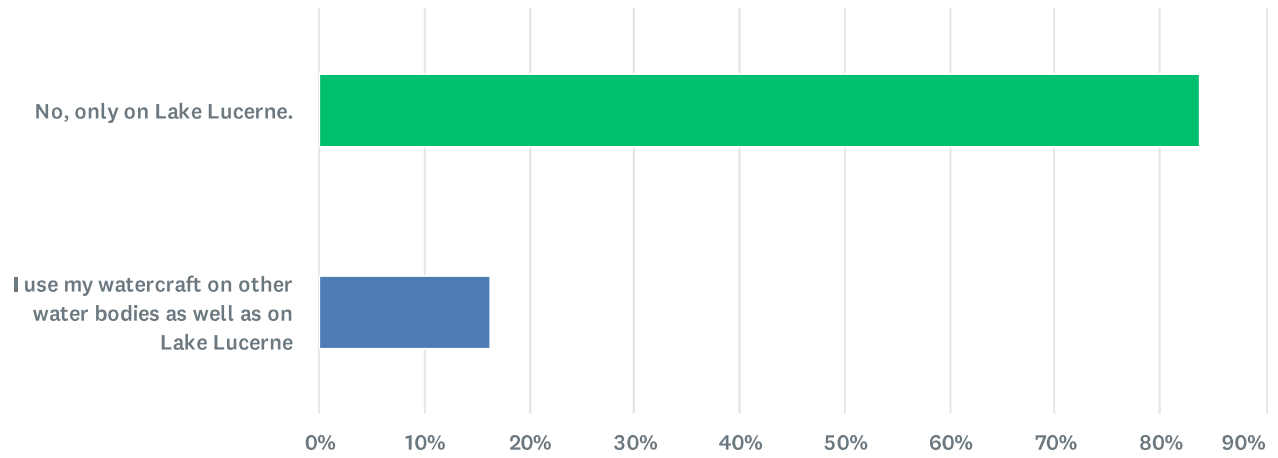

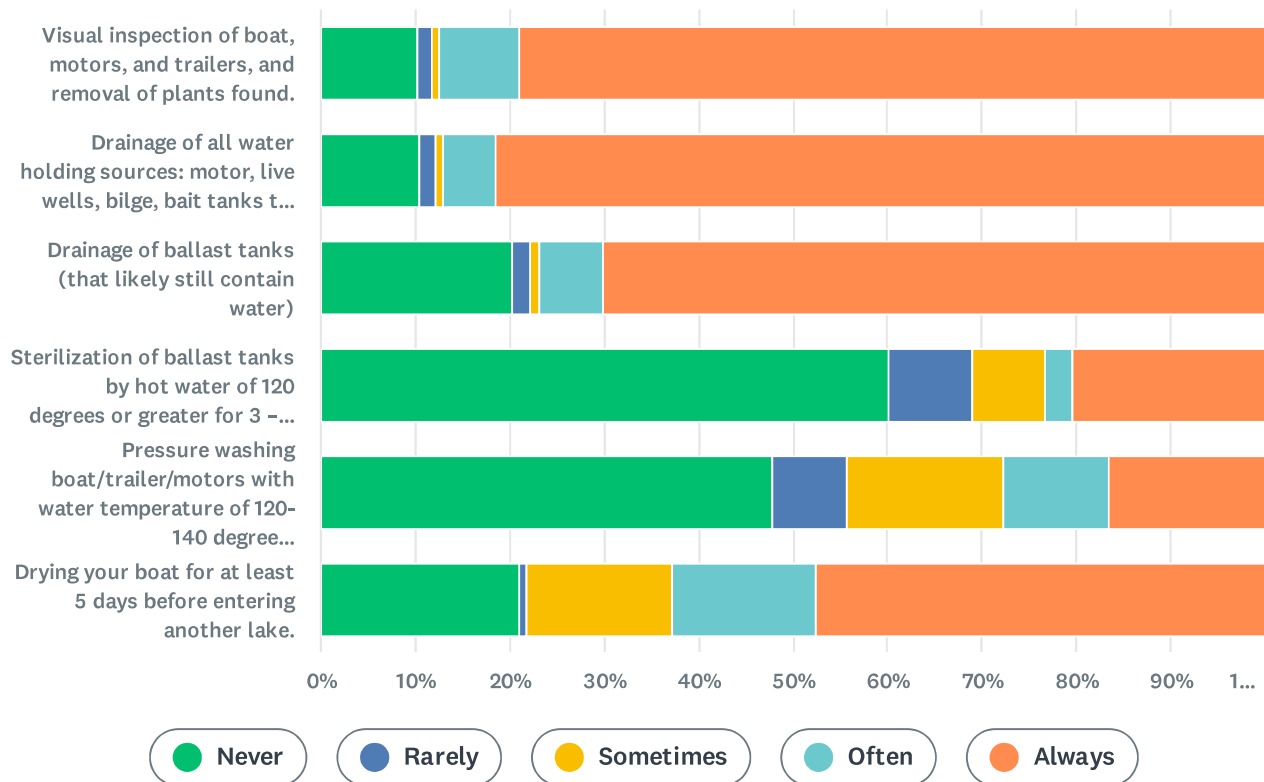

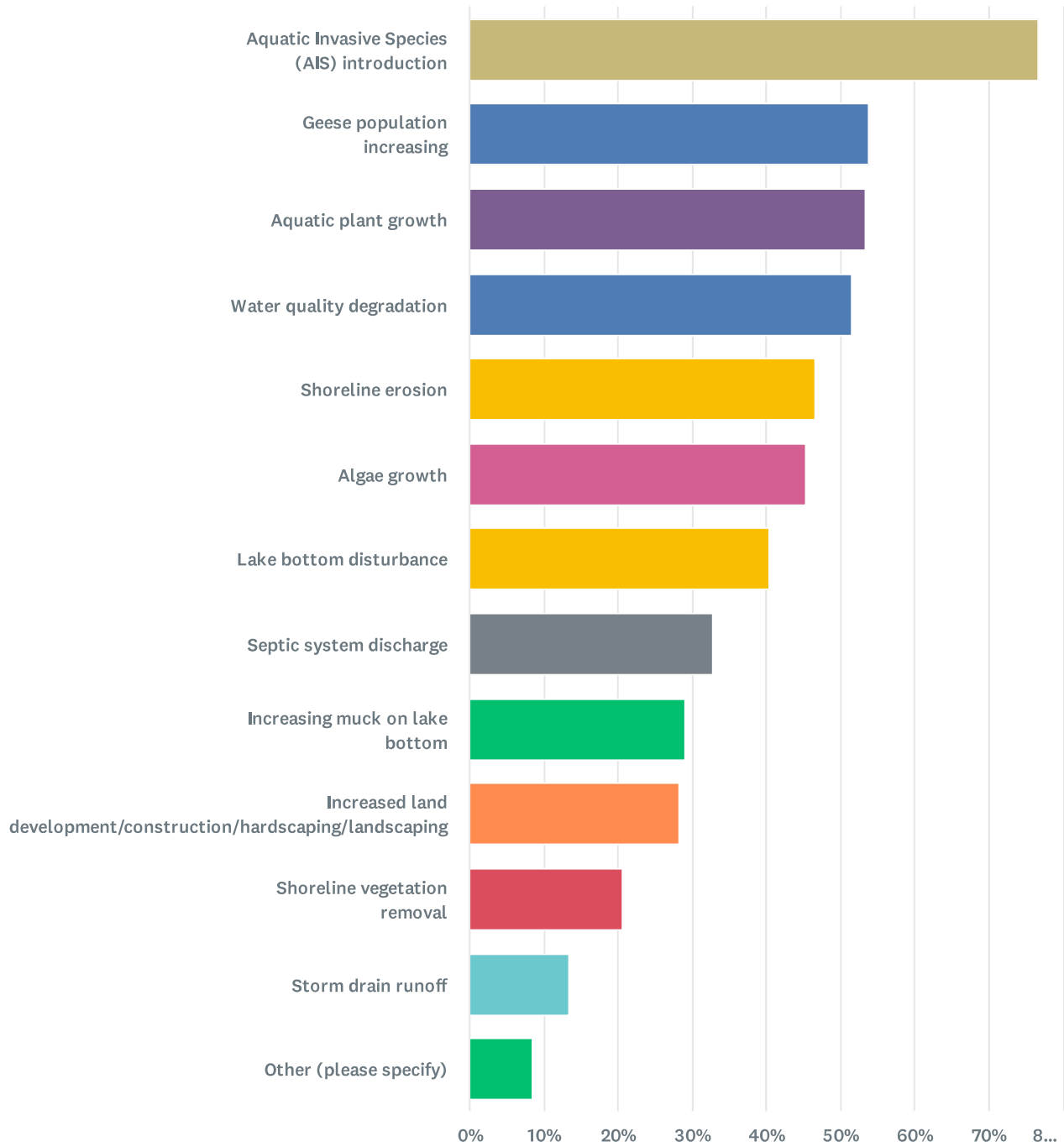
Q13 What type of cleaning routine do you use after using your boat on other lakes or rivers other than Lake Lucerne? (Indicate your practices)?

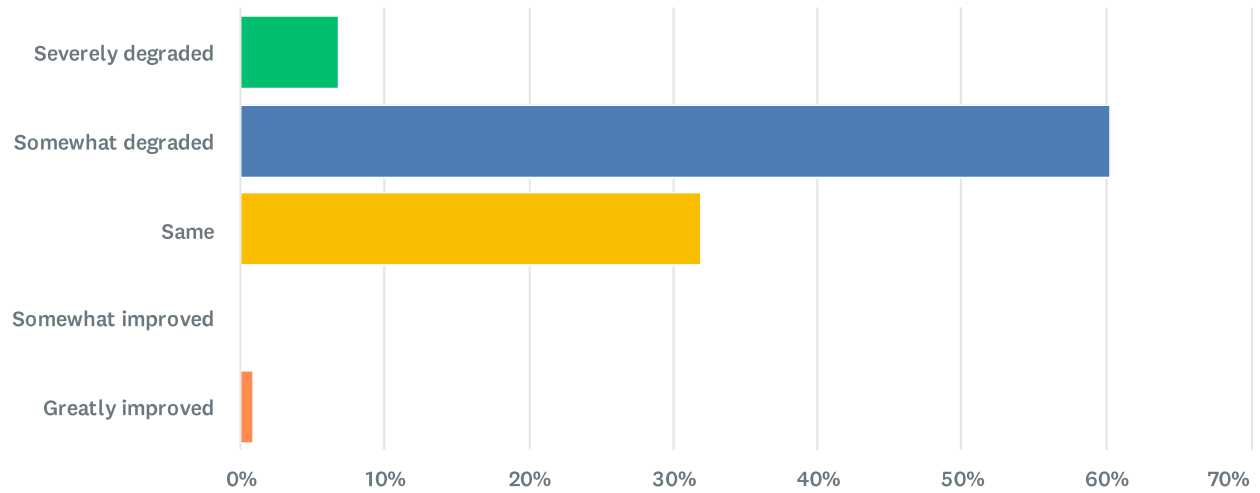
Q21 During the years you have been familiar with Lake Lucerne, what changes, if any, have you seen in the aquatic plants?

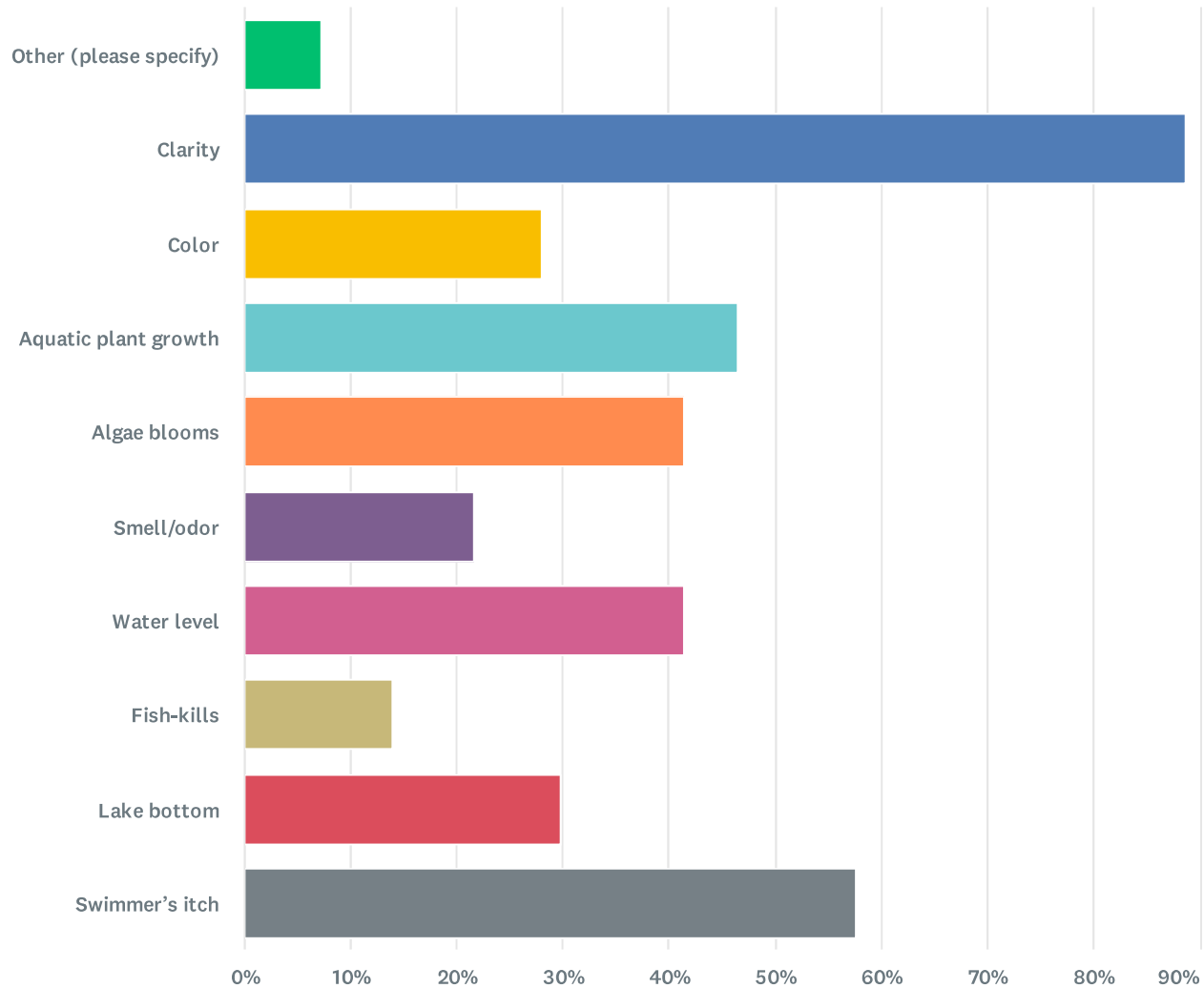
Q22 How has overall water quality changed since you first visited Lake Lucerne?

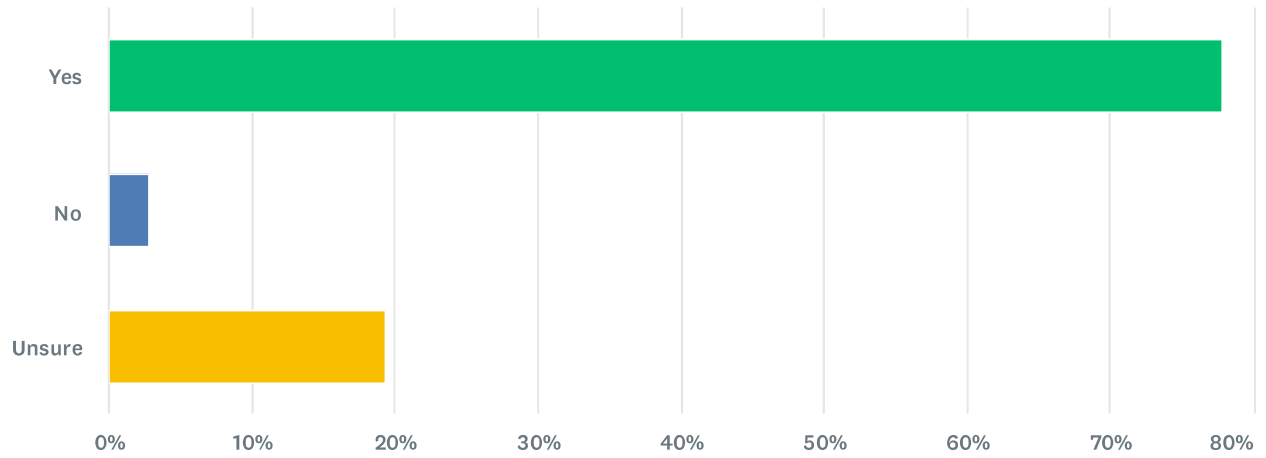

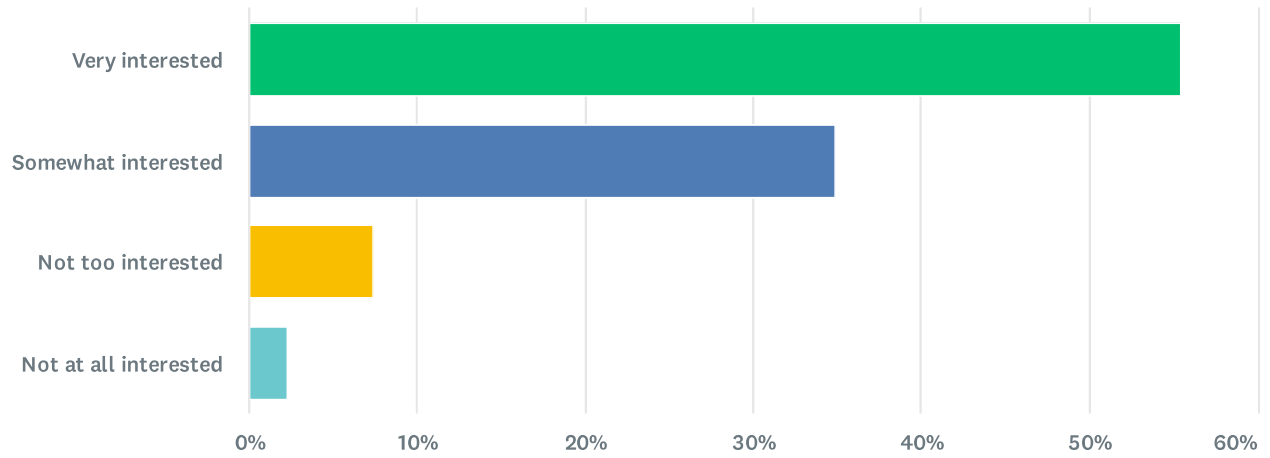
Q28 Do you believe that aquatic plant management is needed on Lake Lucerne?

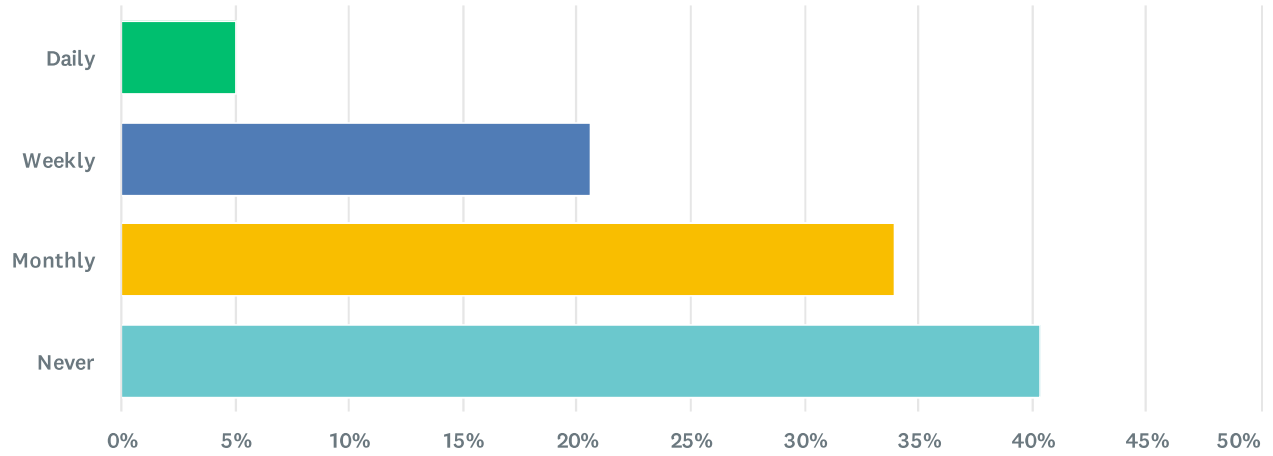
Q29 How interested would you be in receiving information about aquatic Invasive species in Lake Lucerne?

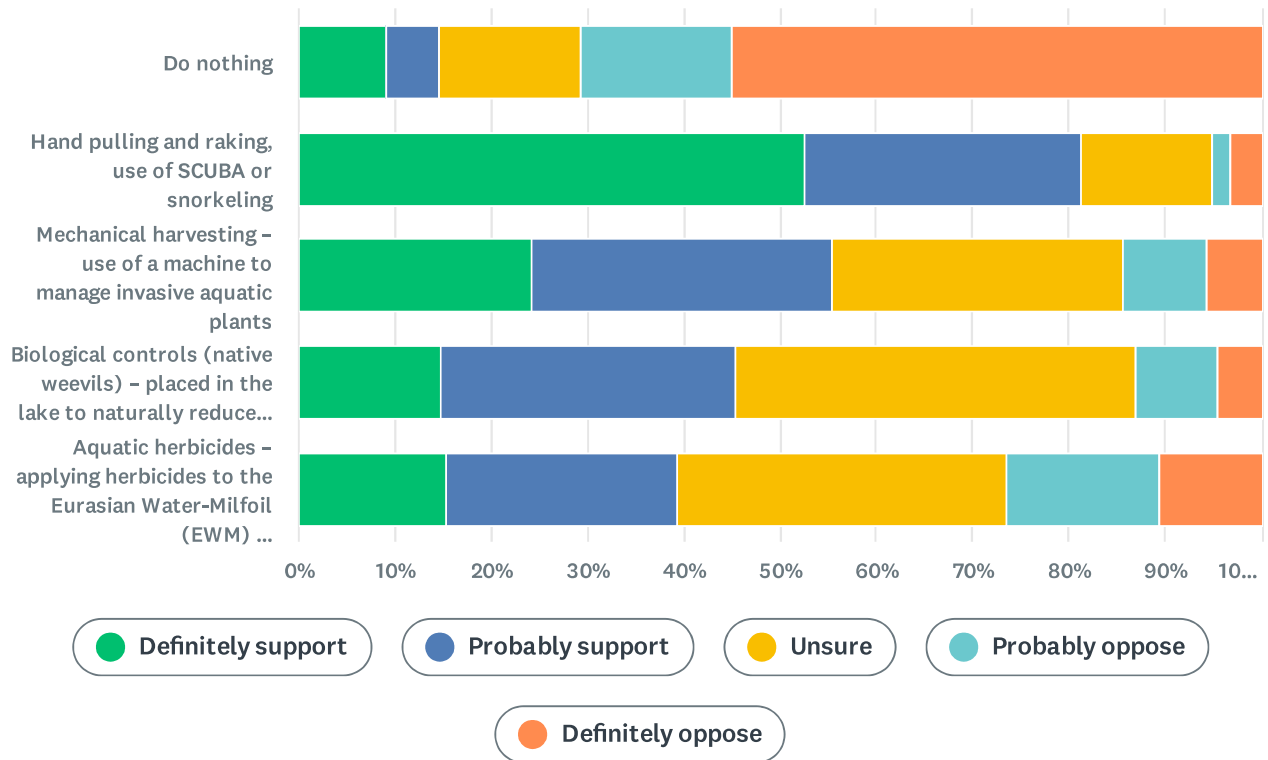

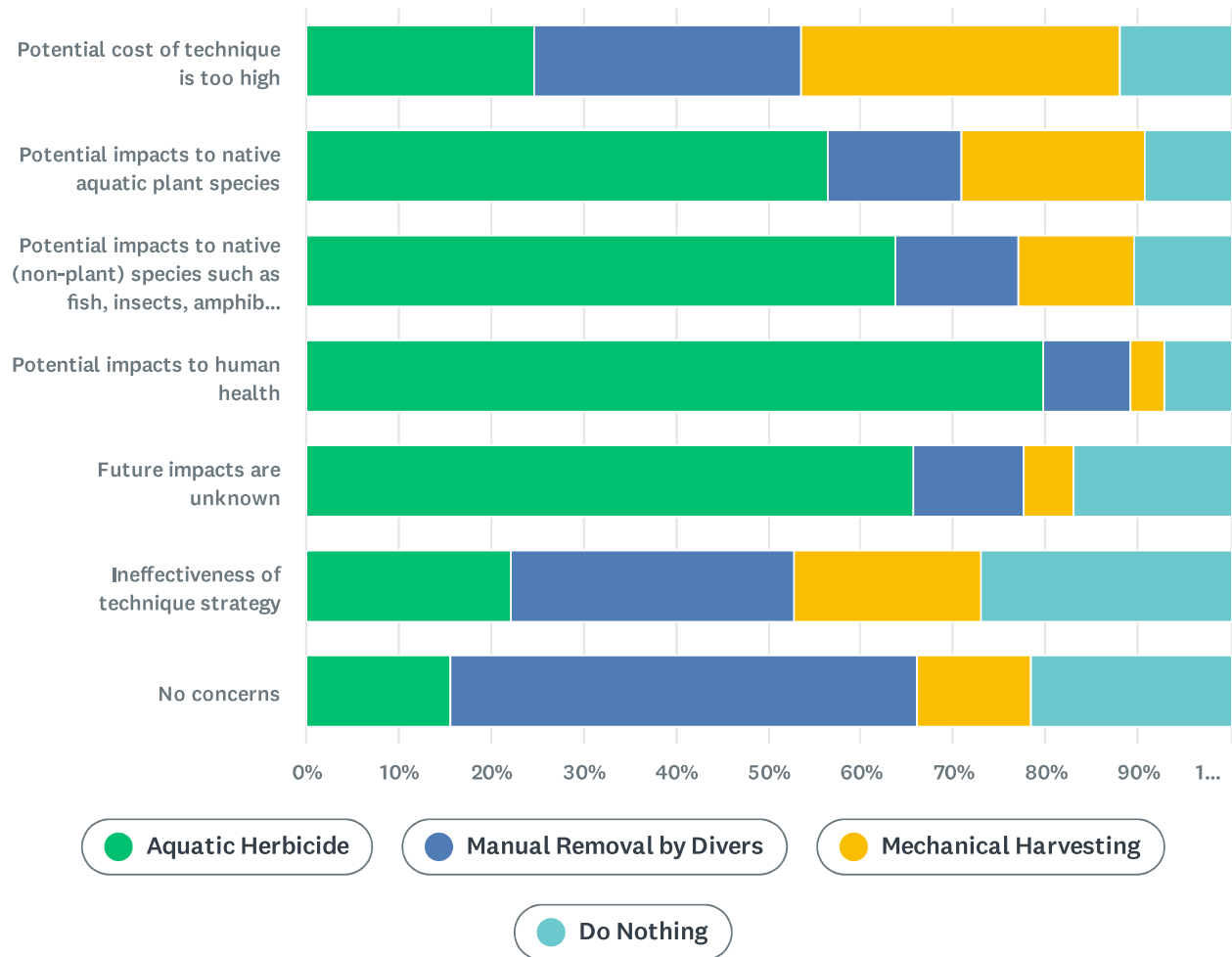
Q32 Below are several methods used by professionals to manage aquatic invasive plant species. Using the following scale, please indicate your level of support or opposition for each control method.

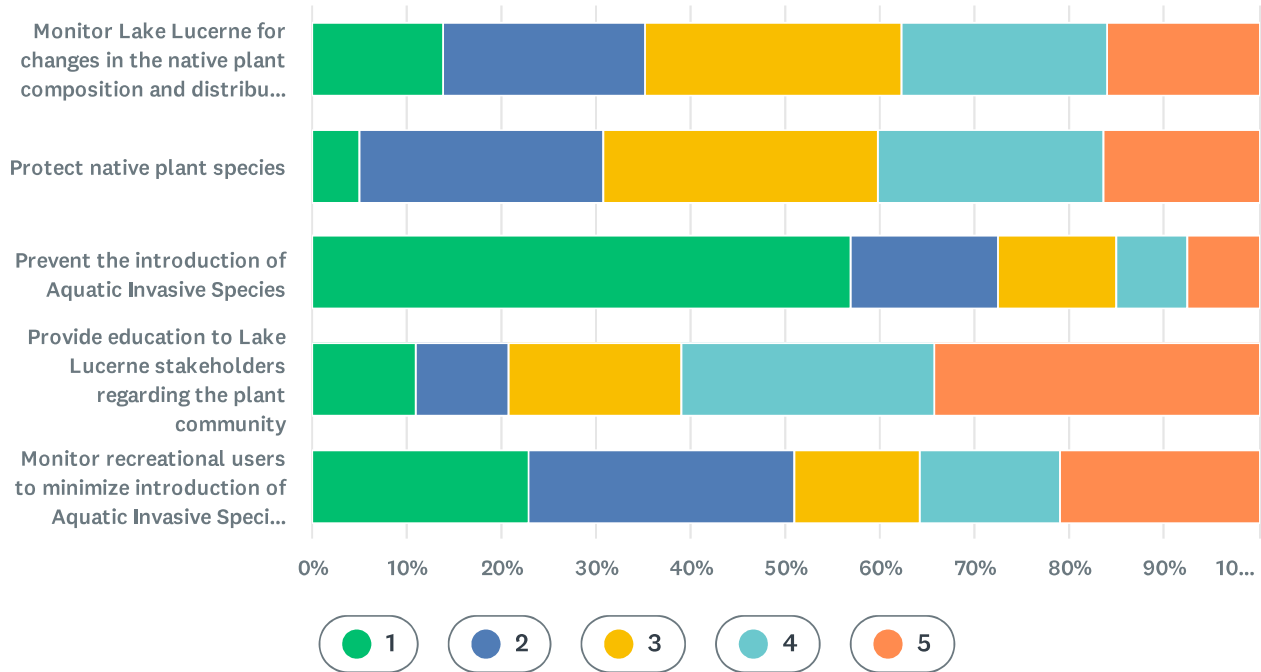
Q33 What concerns, if any, do you have for the future use of the following management techniques to manage Eurasian Water-Milfoil (EWM) in Lake Lucerne?

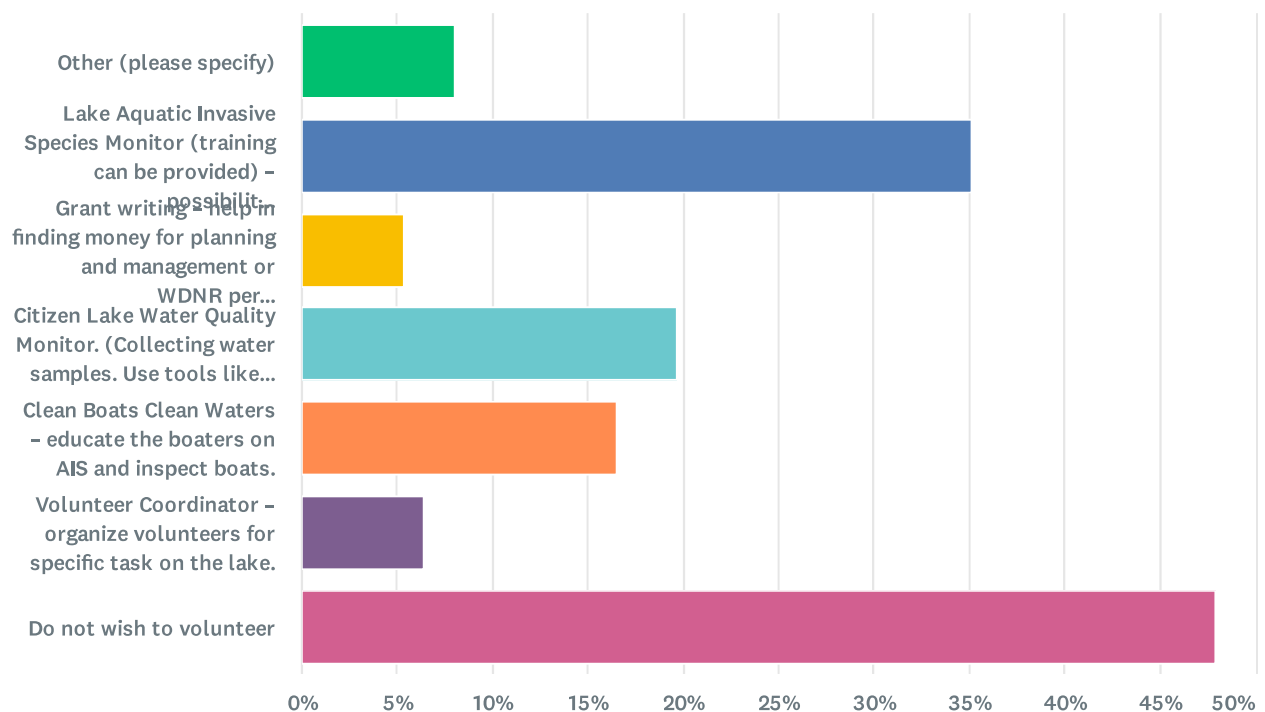
